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EVANGELIST NICK HALL AND AWARD-WINNING ARTIST MICAH TYLER LEAD FAMILY CHRISTMAS EXPERIENCE WITH NEARLY 1,300 GOSPEL RESPONSES ACROSS EIGHT NORTH DAKOTA CITIES

Each Event Drew a Packed House as Global Ministry Visits North Dakota To Share the Reason for the Christmas Season

MINNEAPOLIS, MN—**December 13, 2023**—<u>Pulse</u>, a global Christian ministry leading one of the largest millennial-led prayer and outreach efforts in the world, visited eight cities in North Dakota to host The Reason: A Family Christmas Experience from November 29 through December 10.

Nick Hall, global evangelist and founder of Pulse, led The Reason as he shared a message of hope with a Gospel presentation. The event drew a packed house with thousands of attendees across the eight cities while simultaneously offering a timely reminder of the true meaning of the Christmas season. Award-winning Christian artist, Micah Tyler, also led the crowds in a time of worship, featuring classic Christmas songs and his hit songs *Different and Even Then*.

All said, nearly 1,300 individuals responded to the Gospel message from Nick Hall. Responses were gathered through printed cards that were distributed to the crowd or via a text-in option. The responses ranged from individuals accepting Jesus for the first time to recommitting their lives to Christ, as well as submitting prayer requests or requesting a follow-up conversation regarding the Gospel.

"What a joy it has been to meet the people of North Dakota over the past two weeks," said Hall. "The Reason is only the beginning of our outreach in North Dakota. I am so grateful to the communities that have welcomed us and allowed us to celebrate the reason for the holiday season with them. We are expectant and hopeful about what will happen in these communities when people reset their lives to Jesus!"

The Reason tour served as a launching pad for <u>Pulse North Dakota</u>'s presence in the state starting in 2024 and continuing through 2025 to reach all ages with the Gospel through an active, two-year campaign.

"We are blown away by the number of people from all over the state and region who were impacted for the Kingdom through The Reason tour," said Hall. "We are eager to continue our outreach efforts in a variety of exciting ways across North Dakota over the next two years and beyond."

There hasn't been an emphasis on evangelistic outreach of this magnitude in North Dakota since <u>Luis Palau</u> and Mission North Dakota in 2000. Alongside the ministry's plans to host gatherings and events, Pulse's aim and purpose is to connect those they encounter back to a local church or ministry, ensuring that their new, old, or renewed faith is encouraged through Christ-driven community. Representatives from the Pulse team have partnered with community and faith leaders to spark action among locals after key outreach events.
